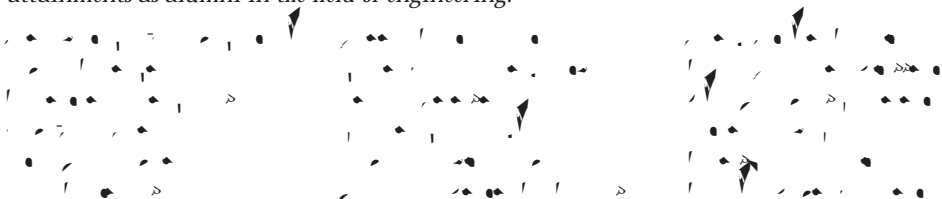
Pi Kappa Lambda was established in 1915 to honor distinguished students for both academic and musical accomplishment.
