Disclosure of this information is pursuant to requirements of the Higher Education Act and the Campus

- (4) After the ghi XYbh@first period of enrollment, if a student withdraws or is dismissed in a subsequent enrollment period, the school may also retain an administrative fee of 15 percent of the total cost of a resident program, or \$400, whichever is less.
- (5) No refund is required for any student who withdraws or is dismissed after completing 60 percent of the potential units of instruction in the current enrollment period unless a student withdraws due to mitigating circumstances, which are those that directly prohibit pursuit of a pro- gram and which are beyond the di XYbhacontrol.

SMU Refund for Wisconsin Students. SMU online/distance education students residing in Wisconsin who cancel their enrollment will receive a full refund of all tuition and fees if they officially withdrawfrom the Uni- versity before the withdrawal deadline listed on the Official University Calendar. The University will issue refunds within 10 business days of withdrawal.
