

- x DPRs for Graduate Programs: Joe Papariector of Enrollment Services for Student Systems and Technologyin the University Registrar's Office, explained that federal financial aid and other regulations require Universities to be able to demonstrate that courses students are taking are counting towards their degrees. For this reason, the Registrar's office is developing Degree Progress Reports (DPRs), which are a means of demonstrating this, for all SMU graduate programs (they exist for undergraduate majors and minors already). 


