- Reminder and update on cluster hire search committees We are pleased to soon begin advertising cluster hires this fall across two areas of strategic research excellence: 1) 21st Century Technology and Education and 2) Earth Hazards and Nationa

• Search process for Associate Provost for Institutional Planning and Effectiveness – Dr. Patty Alvey, Associate Provost for Institutional Planning and Effectiveness, has expressed her intention to retire from her position effective December 31, 2021. Dr Alvey has been an integral member of the Provost's leadership team, and during her tenure, has done an outstanding service to the University both as accreditation liaison and in establishing and leading a robust Office of Institutional Planning and Effectiveness offering.

The position will be vacant due to Dr. Michael Harris's decision, after six years of outstanding service, to transition into a new role as Department Chair for Education Policy and Leadership. Applications are due on October 1.
